# Wet-seal "A Coat"

## DESCRIPTION

**Wet-seal "A Coat"** is a 2-part epoxy waterproofing system, and is jade in colour. **Wet-seal "A Coat"** when cured is a seamless membrane that will not bleed through porous materials.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

Fall should be incorporated in the original concrete slab pour where possible. Allow concrete to cure for 28 days and cement render to cure for 7 days prior to application of **Wet-seal "A Coat"**. Damp surfaces can be coated using **Wet-seal "A Coat"**. The plumbing and wall sheets must be installed prior to the application of **Wet-seal "A Coat"**. Drainage Flanges must be installed on suspended floors prior to application of the membrane. Surfaces must be clean, and all grease, oil, wax, curing compounds, dust, droppings, loose material, paint or other contaminants must be removed. Fibrous cement sheeting must be fixed in accordance to manufacturers' directions. Hobs (if applicable) must be constructed from brick, or other impervious material.

## APPLICATION

**Wet-seal "A Coat"** is for internal waterproofing areas such as Showers, Bathrooms, Ensuites, Powder Rooms and Laundries. It is used when smell could be an issue, as it has **very little odour**. **Wet-seal "A Coat"** is a supply and fix system, and is only installed by **Wet-seal's** Franchisees.

## CURING TIME

A minimum of 48 hours depending on weather conditions, more time may be required in some conditions.

## TILING AND MORTAR BED COVERING

This may be carried out after the **Wet-seal "A Coat"** has been allowed to cure.

**Please Note: If a hob is used in the shower ensure that hob tiles are grouted with a flexible grout.**

## TILE ADHESIVE – INTERNAL AREAS

**WIPE OVER** the "**Wet-seal Membrane**" thoroughly, with clean water **OR** methylated spirits **PRIOR** to application of any **two part flexible adhesive**.

## LIMITATIONS

**Wet-seal "A Coat"** membrane should never be used as an exposed finish.

## GUARANTEE

**Wet-seal "A Coat"** carries a ten-year material guarantee.
